Financial Review

Total Income: 2.9% below budget // 0.7% above last year

Offerings & Gifts closed 10.0% above budget and declined -13.1% vs last year

TOTAL NET INCOME for the month showed a loss of -\$5,150.08 after mortgage principal pmt

YTD (July – April)

YTD Total Expenses stand -13.3% below budget // 0.8% below last year

Total Income stands -1.8% below budget // -12.4% below last year

Offerings & gifts trending 2.64% above budget // -4.15% below last year

YTD NET INCOME stands at \$7,052.17 after mortgage principal pmt

Operations Report

Jonathan presented an operations report. Highlights include the church softball game on May 15th with around 140 people attending. Our combined operations programs have a positive net income for the month of April and year to date. Enrollment for 2021/22 kindergarten is at 19/20 spots filled, and 1st grade at 16/20 spots filled. Pre-K is full at 20/20 and they are taking reservations to open a second Pre-K class.

Note: In contrast, 1 1/2 years ago it only had \$48,000 total compared to over \$67,000 today. Up 30%, not including distributions this year.

Lay Ministers Report

Keith Cook met with Pastor Dan to do some brainstorming about Lay Ministry and submitted the following report: Considering revamping Lay Ministry to focus on where we can have the greatest impact on meeting the needs of our members. Pastor Dan provided a great overview of the filtering criteria capabilities associated with our church database program. It should be a valuable tool moving forward.

Alice continues to be in charge of and does a great job checking in on members. Pastor Dan and I also discussed the new phone system and how we believe it can be used to call from home and have a caller ID of St. Luke's appear on the receiving end. This could be useful in getting volunteer help for Alice with member check in calls and the volunteers could work from home, but have a St. Luke's caller ID.

I've had a few calls with Ruth Hileman about Telecare. Our plan is to merge Telecare into the great work Alice is doing to call and check in with various members that we haven't heard from for a while. Ruth will be contacting Alice to see how she can best assist.

I found out the Card Ministry program has been continuing throughout the pandemic. I received a great recap and update from Alice Phillips and I have a call into Kathy Britt to get more details.

Aside from the one couple we are working with, the Marriage Ministry is on hold.
